

RESIDENTIAL LIFETIME WARRANTY

This warranty is effective for all Cascade Windows products¹ manufactured on or after August 17, 2009. Any previous warranties will continue to apply to products manufactured by Cascade Windows prior to this date. For additional information, including care, maintenance, and installation instructions visit our website at www.CascadeWindows.com.

Residential Lifetime Warranty (Owner-Occupied Single-Family Residences)

Each Cascade Windows product will be free from defects in materials or workmanship for the original owner of an owner-occupied single-family residence for which the Cascade Windows product(s) are initially installed for as long the original owner owns and occupies the residence.

Transferability

The Owner-Occupied Single-Family Residence Lifetime Warranty is transferable as follows. In the event you sell your residence, or it becomes occupied by anyone other than the original owner, the warranty is valid for five years from the original purchase date of the Cascade Windows.

Cascade Windows requires reasonable access to nonconforming product. This warranty gives you specific legal rights. You may have other rights that vary from state to state.

Requesting Service

Immediately upon finding any problem with a Cascade Windows product, submit a Service Order Request using our online form. Access the Service Request Form at www.CascadeWindows.com/service-order-request and a representative will contact you within 48 hours of your form submission. (Important: If a problem is found before the product is installed, DO NOT install the product.) We can respond more efficiently if you provide the following:

- Your name, address and daytime phone numbers.
- Sales receipt or other documentation establishing proof and date of purchase.
- The name of the dealer or contractor that originally supplied the product.
- A description of the problem.

Upon notification, we will investigate the problem. If the product is found to be defective, and is covered under the provisions of this warranty, Cascade Windows will provide the labor and/or materials needed to repair the product at no charge. If the defect cannot be repaired, Cascade Windows will provide a replacement² product and ship it to the original delivery site.

This Warranty Does Not Cover

Cascade Windows is not liable for:

- Normal wear and tear, and natural weathering or fading of surfaces and/or hardware finishes, including corrosion in highly corrosive environments.
- Glass breakage; failure due to misuse or abuse; and damage caused by failure to provide maintenance, by alteration or modification to the window (e.g. customer applied tints or films, paint finishes, improperly installed security systems or blinds³), or as a result of any cause beyond the control of Cascade Windows (e.g. fire, flood, earthquake, other acts of nature).

- Improper handling, installation, maintenance or operation not in conformance with Cascade Windows installation instructions; problems related to water and/or air infiltration/leaking; flaws in building design or construction or sloped glazing or other non-vertical installation.
- Damage or poor product performance resulting from installation into a condition that exceeds product design standards and/or certified performance specifications and/or is not in compliance with building codes. Damage from settling or movement of the home. Damage from condensation. (Please Note: Unless due to insulating glass failure, most condensation problems are related to excessive humidity levels in a structure. Contact a heating/air conditioning specialist for help.)
- Labor and materials for the installation of a complete replacement product or any repainting or finishing required in connection with any warranty work.
- Product that has not been paid for.
- Product sold by Cascade Windows as clearance items, seconds, blemished, or in "as is" condition.
- Incidental or consequential damage. Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so this may not apply to you.

¹ "Cascade Windows products" shall refer to vinyl windows and sliding glass doors manufactured by Window Products, Inc., and marketed under the Cascade Windows brand name for use in the United States.

Frequently Asked Questions

Low-E Glass (Ec & Ec+)

- Q: What is a Low-E coating? (Low-Emissivity)
- A: A very thin layer of metallic oxide or silver that has been applied and then baked onto the glass surface. The coating is approximately 3,000 times thinner than a piece of paper.
- Q: How does Low-E work?
- A: Low-E blocks radiant heat transfer, keeping heat from escaping or entering a home.
- Q: Does Low-E reduce solar heat gain?
- A: Yes, Low-E reduces solar heat gain by reflecting or redirecting much of the radiant heat the sun sends toward your home.
- Q: Will Low-E glass eliminate fading of carpets or upholstery?
- A: Although Low-E reduces a significant amount of ultraviolet light, it will not completely eliminate fading. The resistance of fabrics to fade varies from product to product.

Condensation

- Q: What is the cause of condensation on windows and patio doors?
- A: The cause is much the same as that of a weather pattern forming rain, but on a smaller scale. Warm, moist air in a room comes into contact with cool surfaces, most notably glass, and deposits water on that surface.
- Q: Why are windows and doors the first place you see condensation?
- A: Windows and doors usually have the lowest surface temperatures of any surface in the house. They are indicators of excessive moisture, which could mean condensation forming inside of walls leading to other problems.

Window Coverings

Coverings installed too close to the glass can cause the glass to crack, the seal to fail, or develop excessive condensation on the glass. When installing blinds, leave a minimum of 2" clearance between glass and shading device, and a 1/2" clearance at the top and bottom, or one side and bottom to allow natural air movement. When choosing blinds or draperies, verticals are recommended over horizontals.

Care Instructions

For the most part, you can care for your new Cascade windows as you would any other window. Common household glass cleaners should be used to clean common dirt or debris from the viewing area. On the vinyl portion of your window, refer to the chart below for guidance.
